Host School - Dulwich College Beijing

Dulwich College Beijing is located in Shunyi, approx. 15 minutes from Beijing International Airport (Peking). Please note that the closest shops to the school are a 5 minute Didi ride. As such, DCB will arrange all catering on-site including lunches, dinners and morning/afternoon snacks. A small corner store is available next to the school from 3:30pm for additional snacks.



Weather and what to wear

The weather in Beijing in February is cold with the average temperatures ranging from -6 degrees Celcius at night and 5 degrees during the day. The air is quite dry at this time. It is best to dress warm but with layers to shed as buildings are very well heated.

Hotel Accommodation - Crowne Hotel Plaza

DCB have a block booking at the Crowne Hotel Plaza in Shunyi. Please note that it is the school's own responsibility to book and pay for the hotel accommodation directly with the hotel. Crowne Plaza hotel is a modern 5-star hotel with a small shopping strip within one minute from the main entrance. Students will depart at 7:45-8:15am each morning and will return to the hotel at 8:30-9:00pm each night.

Schools should arrive on Wendesday Feburary 21 at the hotel and depart on Sunday February 25.

In 2008 the International Schools Choral Music Society (ISCMS) hosted its first festival, culminating in a performance of Faure's Requiem. More than 100 students from 9 International Schools participated.

ISCMS has grown ever since, and in 2019 ISCMS XII was held at the Shanghai Symphony Hall, with nearly 400 performers from 26 schools.

ISCMS returns this year after multiple delays due to the COVID pandemic with the ISCMS XIII festival culmintating in a performance at the Forbidden City Concert Hall in Beijing.
